

# Evening Gown with Jeweled Embroidery

from Harper's Bazar January 2, 1897

The Skirt pattern is given with the full dimensions in inches marked on it. The front and sides are interlined about half their depth, and the middle back breadths throughout. The top of the skirt is fitted by darts at the front and gathered at the back; and the points \* are tacked upon an elastic strap. The pattern of the bodice is given in Figs. 6-12; it is fastened at the back. The belt is cut of bias silk from Fig. 11; it is pleated at the side by bringing X to ●, and shirred with a heading at the back, which is stiffened with a whale bone. The pattern of the jacket piece is given in Fig. 10; it is fitted by darts as indicated. Fig. 12 gives the pattern of the small sleeve, which is gathered between the marks \*, and is sewed in with the sleeve seam meeting the armhole notch.
